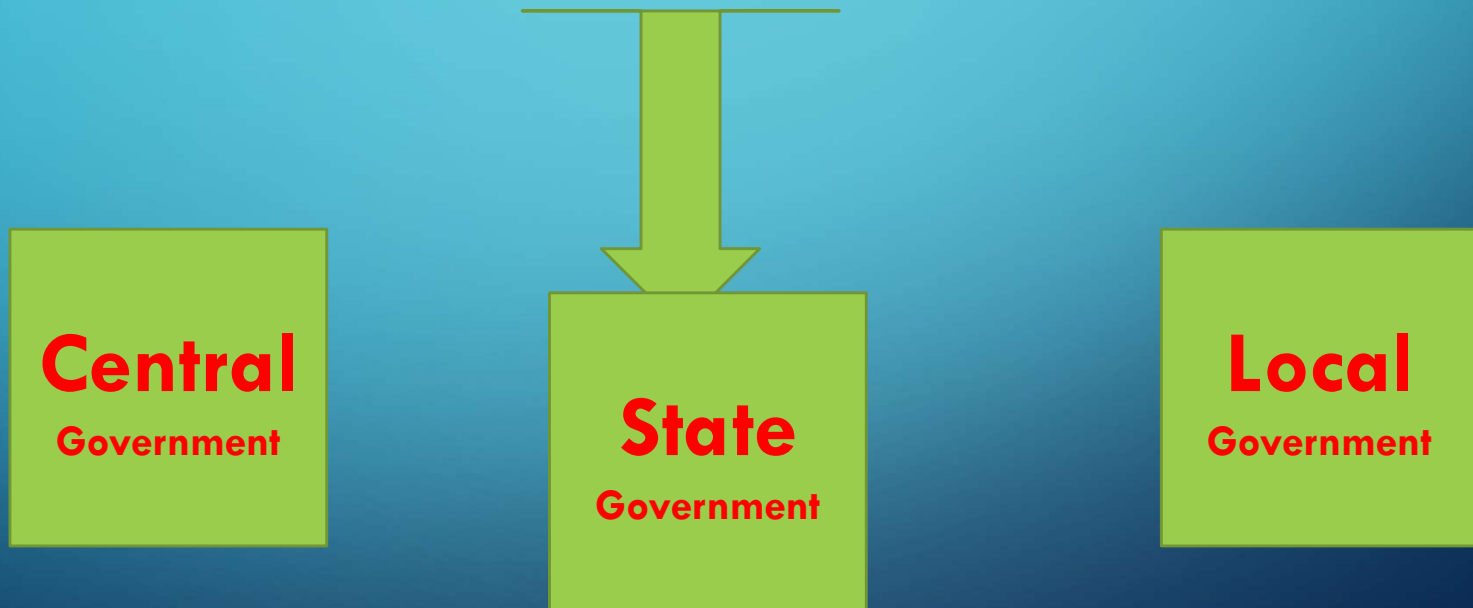

- **Meaning :-**

**The term Local Government literally means management of the Local affairs by the people of the locality.**

## **DEFINITION:-**

### **1) L. Jennings :-**

**Local Government as  
Governmental organs having jurisdiction not  
over the whole of a country but over  
specified portion of it.**

## **2) B.K.Gokhale:-**

**Local government is the government of specific locality by the local people through the representative elected by them.**

## **CHARACTERISTICS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT:-**

- **Fixed area.**
- **Administered by an authority or body.**
- **Right to change it(Accountability).**
- **To provide certain civil amenities.**
- **Concerned about the overall development of the people.**

- **To provide opportunity to local people to participate actively in administration.**
- **To encourage and train talented people.**
- **To provide local authority means freedom of the government to decide and act in the sphere of activities and functions allotted to them by statute.**
- **To provide opportunity for public opinion in favour of developmental efforts.**

- **To provide opportunities for group communication.**
- **To motivate people.**
