The Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981

Objectives:

- To provide for the prevention, control and abatement of air pollution
- To provide for establishment of Central and State Boards, with a view to implement the aforesaid purpose;
- To provide for conferring on such Boards powers and assigning to such Boards functions relating thereto
- To lay down standards for maintain the quality of air.

- S/2(a): **Air Pollution** means the presence in the atmosphere of air pollutant
- s/ 2 (b): **Air Pollutant** : Air pollutant means any solid , liquid or gaseous substance including noise present in the atmosphere in such concentration as may be or tend to be injurious to human beings or other living creatures or plants or property or environment
